CAROLINA MEEHL, BELOVED WIFE OF WILLIAM MEEHL, A WELL KNOWN AND HIGHLY RESPECTED RESIDENT OF THAT VICINITY. DECENDENT WAS A NATIVE OF MINNESOTA, HAVING BEEN BORN IN THE TOWN IN WHICH HER DEMISE OCCURRED. SHE WAS BORN AUGUTST 15, 1866, ON THE LOT NEXT TO THE ONE OCCUPIED BY THE FAMILY AT THE TIME OF HER DEATH. He returned and farmed in Forest Township for 25 years. In 1920 he married Sadie T. Johnson of Millersburg. They had 2 children, Lloyd who works at Northwest Airlines and lives in St. Paul, and Irene who is married to "Gene" Milo E. Searle and lives in Faribault. For many years, in addition to farming, he graded roads in Rice County with a horse-drawn grader and also helped build many roads in the area. He was a member of the town board and school board. In 1948 they moved to Faribault and he was an engineer at the Minnesota School for the Blind and St. Mary's Hall until he retired. They also managed a Laundromat for 16 years. Sadie was also employed for a number of years at the Faribault Woolen Mills. Henry's greatest pastime in his later years, which he dearly loved, was fishing. He could always be seen in the early morning hours fishing by the Woolen Mills or King Mill. Later in the day he would head for the lakes where he had a boat. He was always a jovial, happy man, who loved life, family and especially children, and was loved by all who knew him. He was always giving of himself and expected nothing in return. MEEHL	JACOB M.	FARIBAULT REPUBLICAN	19/AUG/1891	ON FRIDAY LAST, AUG. 14, AN AGED GERMAN FARMER WHO LIVED ON SECTION 21 IN THE TOWN OF FOREST, WENT OUT TO WATER HIS CATTLE. A BULL THAT HAD BROKEN INTO THE ENCLOSURE WITH THE OTHER CATTLE CAME UP AND ATTACKED HIM FROM BEHIND, KNOCKING HIM DOWN AND TRAMPLING UPON HIM. THE BULL HAD BEEN DEPRIVED OF HIS HORNS, SO HE DID NOT GORE HIS VICTIM. MR. MEEHL'S SON, WHO LIVES WITH HIM, WAS ABSENT, BUT THE WOMAN OF THE HOUSE SAW THE ATTACK, AND RAN OUT AND DROVE THE BULL AWAY. THEY CARRIED MR. MEEHL INTO THE HOUSE, BUT HE HAD RECEIVED INJURIES FROM WHICH HE DIED IN ABOUT AN HOUR. DECEASED WAS AN OLD RESIDENT, HAVING LIVED IN THE TOWN OF FOREST OVER THIRTY YEARS, AND WAS MUCH RESPECTED. HE LEAVES A WIFE, HENRIETTA A. PETERS MEEHL, THREE SONS AND TWO DAUGHTERS. TWO OF HIS SONS LIVE IN MARSHALL. THE FUNERAL SERVICES WERE HELD ON SUNDAY LAST.

MEEHL	JACOB	BIOGRAPHY	<p>BOOK - RICE COUNTY FAMILIES. PUBLISHED IN 1981. Jacob Meehl was born in Damstad, Germany in 1819. He was married in 1846 in Germany to Henrietta Amelia Peters, who was born in 1828 in Hessen Nauser, Germany. They migrated to the United States in 1851, settling in Sullivan County, Pa. and in 1863 moved to Forest Township, Rice County, where a homestead was taken. It is interesting to note that the name Meehl was spelled Muhl and Meal. In Germany the Meehl family were "Millers of wheat" hence the name Meehl was derived. The original homestead papers were located in the general land offices of the National Archives in Washington, D. C. Jacob Meehl made an affidavit to certify that he was married and gave his intention to become a citizen of the United States. This affidavit was made in connection with the taking of a homestead. Thereafter and on the same day, May 6, 1863 before Henry A. Swift, Registrar of the land office in St. Peter, Minnesota (who later became Governor of Minnesota) he made an affidavit wherein he stated that he had made settlement upon and cultivated the land. Also that he had built a house thereon 19 x 24 with a kitchen 14 x 24, a log cabin house, story and a half high, two floors, 7 windows and 3 doors, also it is a comfortable house for a family to live in. Jacob and Henrietta had nine children, Christina, Anna, Jacob, Mary, Elizabeth, Henry, William, Margaret and John. Christine was married to a Taylor and her husband died around 1879. During the Diphtheria epidemic of 1881, she lost three of her children during the winter. She has four surviving children, Emma, Bill, Mary & Frank. Jacob married Louise Voss and they had seven children, Etta, John, Bob, George, Maggie, Doris and Clifford. Elizabeth married a Giesecking, they had a son William and an adopted daughter Emma. Mary married a Kirchner, who later died. They had a daughter Molly who also died. She later married a Huebner. They had three children, Charles, Minnie and Agnes (McCollum). 			<p>three children namely Eva (Powell), Harry and May (Danielson). His wife died and he later married Bessie Jaques. They had seven children. Percy, Bob, Dorothy, Madeline, John and Gladys. William married Caroline Voss. They had ten children, Edward, William, Arthur, Henry, Goodwin, Elizabeth, Anne & Therasa (twins) Clara & Cora (twins). Minnie married George Shaw and had eight children. Ruth (Christoferson), Elsie (Tucker), Minnie (Vedin), Lizzy (Hauber), George, Marie (Shields), Jennie (Moberg), and Howard. John married Lydia Flatz. They had five children Ray, Roy, Ralph, Ruth and Rose. Lydia was well known because of her maternity home in Morristown for many years. Margaret married Charles De Mann. They had six children. Eva (Sharp), Henrietta (Ludwig), Frank, Elizabeth (Taggert), Esther (Amstutz), and Jacob. Jacob died in 1891. It was interesting to note the article of his death in the Faribault Pilot dated August 17, 1891. It went into great detail stating "Jacob Meehl, while watering stock in his pasture last Friday, was attacked by a vicious bull and was bruised and injured to that he died in a few minutes. His wife and daughter saw him being tossed in the air. They assisted him to the house. He had a large gash in the back of his head from which the blood was flowing and he complained of great pain. His son William was summoned immediately and only arrived to see him breathe his last. The funeral took place on Sunday afternoon and was largely attended. Over forty teams followed his remains to their last resting place". Henrietta passed away in 1902.</p>
